DANCE GUIDELINES

It is the hope of our school community that our dances are wonderful events for all involved. In that regard, it is the responsibility of each student attending all dances to know and understand the following guidelines:

- All students and guests will abide by the rules of Half Moon Bay High School. Failure to comply with school rules will result in dismissal from the dance and may result in further disciplinary action. Note: Appropriate behavior at a Half Moon Bay High School Dance is defined as behavior that does not reflect and /or ensue a lack of respect for any other individual at the dance or the school community as a whole. Rather, appropriate behavior reflects the positive and respectful behavior so established through the Half Moon Bay High School Student Handbook and Code of Conduct.
- All attendees will need a ticket to enter dance.
- If at any time you leave the building during the dance you may not return. See a chaperone for any extenuating circumstances for permission.
- All students will dress appropriately. Students deemed inappropriately dressed will not be admitted to the dance. Semi-Formal dances require a collared shirt and tie. Students who do not remain properly dressed during the dance will be asked to leave.
- Any suspicion of drug or alcohol use will result in non-admittance or removal from school grounds. Additionally all rules contained in the student handbook will apply and involvement from outside agencies will occur as appropriate.
- Any dancing considered dangerous, aggressive, or suggestive in any manner will not be allowed. This includes, but is not limited to, moshing, grinding, etc. Chaperones will determine what are and what are not appropriate forms of dance.
- All dance attendees, their vehicles, and their articles are subject to search if suspicion of illegal/illicit behavior arises. Additionally, all dance attendees are subject to a Breathalyzer test upon entry of the dance at the discretion of dance chaperones.
